CSUSB Instant Admit Days at College of the Desert on Aug. 28: Transfer students can fast-track to spring 2025 admissions

PALM DESERT, Calif. – CSUSB is coming to College of the Desert for Instant Admit Days on Wednesday, Aug. 28, from 9 a.m.-noon.

CSUSB Instant Admit Days provides students a new and easy way to transfer to Cal State San Bernardino.

At the event, which will take place in the Cravens Student Services Center at College of the Desert, transfer students will meet with CSUSB admissions counselors and evaluators to determine their eligibility for spring 2025 admissions.

An on-the-spot review of coursework will be conducted, and qualified students will receive a guaranteed “Coyote Pass,” ensuring pre-approval or an admissions seat for the semester.

All appointments for the College of the Desert event have been booked, but walk-ins will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

By attending Instant Admit Days, students can submit their CSUSB application with confidence and reserve their spot for spring 2025. Registration is now open, and applications will be accepted through Sept. 15. Classes start in January.

Cal State San Bernardino has more than 70 traditional baccalaureate and master's degree programs, education credential and certificate programs, and a doctoral program, all housed within five academic colleges and the Palm Desert Campus.

Students can apply to any non-impacted major, psychology and criminal justice. However, nursing, kinesiology, allied health, and social work are impacted and will not be accepting applications.
